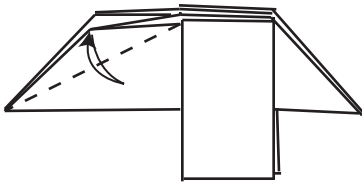
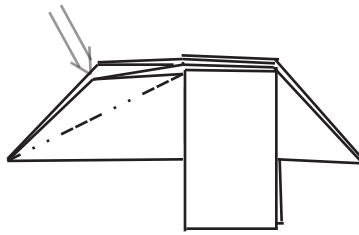

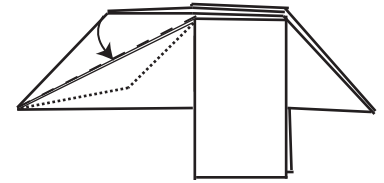
Valley fold top layer.

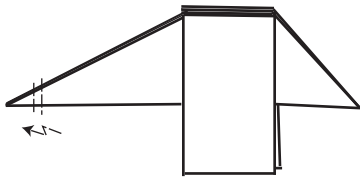
Sink. Creating a pocket.

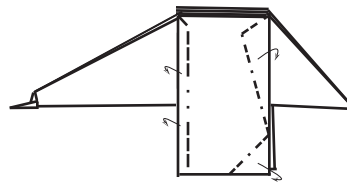
Fold the back layer inside the pocket created in the previous step.

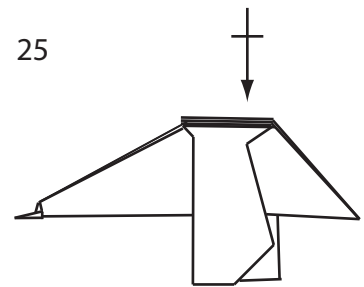
Crimp fold.

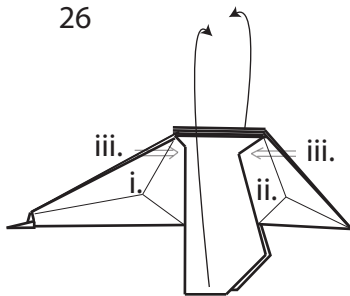
Mountain folds. You don't have to follow this exactly. The final shape will be to taste.

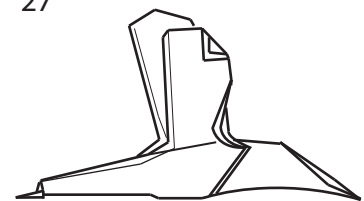


Now for the hard part. Making this look like a Duck. Relax, it's pretty easy. Just the diagramming is crappy.

- i. Double rabbit ear the neck.
- ii. Double rabbit ear the tail.
- iii. Raise the wings (90 to 135 degrees) and narrow the wings' area attached to the body further. This will also help fix the wings in position.

What you are doing is making the Duck 3-D. Make the neck as thin as possible. The body at the top should curve in and down. Flatten the bottom of the body also.
