

Pinch the wings, pull out and lift up to about the top of the head level at a 45 degrees angle.




Do a little valley fold on the wings to thin and give them depth.




i. Spread the wings apart.ii. Open up th

ii. Open up the model to about a 90 degrees angle.

iii. Shape the cowel on existing precreases.




Circled area. Pinch this part of the cowel around the arm edge beneath. This will give the cowel more definition. Repeat on the other side.



You have a Standing Angel with arms outstretched.

Inside reverse fold at point a. It should be less than the white border. Make sure you get the edge straight and don't overlap corner b.



Flying Angel.

If you put one arm end inside the other you get a Praying Angel. By changing and modifying the arms and robe. You can make different types of postures for the Angel. It's possible to give the Angel hands. Try to make a Kneeling Angel, a Blessing Angel and an Ascending Angel.
